



Objective of Procurement of AI CoP

Support public buyers in procuring AI-enabled solutions that are trustworthy, fair and secure

Goals and Objectives

- The work is linked to building public algorithm <u>registers</u> by the <u>Living in</u>
 <u>EU</u> movement
- The information requested in the contractual clauses should be declared in a standardised format to support interoperable and automated exchange.



Development of EU model AI clauses by CoP

April 2023 - Draft EU Al contractual clauses

- Building upon the work of the City of Amsterdam and Helsinki
- Aligned with the upcoming Al Act
- Drafted by Jeroen Naves / Pels Rijcken (Dutch Law Firm)
- A high Risk Version and a Non high Risk Version



Development of EU model AI clauses

June 2023 - Two Round Tables led by Living in EU and Pels Rijcken

- To peer review both (high risk and non high risk) draft clauses
- More than 40 experts from different background participated
- Useful feedback received



Development of EU model AI clauses

October 2023 - New Version available and translated in All EU languages
