

Europe's Most Ambitious Innovation Programme





- "EU factory of unicorns"
- Budget of over €10 billion (21-27) as part of Horizon Europe;
- Focus on Deep Tech & Scale Up in line with the New European Innovation Agenda;
- Full cycle from research (EIC Pathfinder) to spinout (EIC Transition) to startup and scaleup (EIC Accelerator);
- Steered by the EIC Board of leading innovators from across Europe.

EIC Schemes and Main Features



Pathfinder (TRL 1-4)

- For consortia
- Early stage research on breakthrough technologies
- Grants up to €3/4 million

Transition (TRL 4-6)

- For consortia and single entities
- Technology maturation from proof of concept to validation
- Business & market readiness
- Grants up to €2.5 million

Accelerator (TRL 6-9)

- For individual SMEs
- Development & scale up of deep-tech/ disruptive innovations by startups/ SMEs
- Blended finance (grants up to €2.5 million;
 equity investment up to €15 million or above)

- Focus on breakthrough, game-changing, marketcreating, deep-tech
- Mainly bottom up, however complemented by targeted funding on strategic technologies/ challenges
- Steered by **EIC Board** of leading innovators (entrepreneurs, investors, researchers, ecosystem)
- Business Acceleration Services (coaches/ mentors, corporates, investors, ecosystem)
- Pro-active management (roadmaps, reviews, reorientations, etc) with EIC Programme Managers
- Fast track access to Accelerator for results from EIT, EIC Pathfinder
- Plug-In access to Accelerator for results from certified national/ regional programmes

EIC Accelerator - Numbers



Horizon EUROPE

On 3 October 2023:

475 companies selected for funding in 2021, 2022 and early 2023

150 investments approved by the EIC Fund for a total close to **€975** million

57 companies with Investment Agreements signed and a total disbursed amount of **€212 million**

PILOT (H2020)

293 companies selected for funding in the context of the H2020 EIC Accelerator Pilot


On 3 October 2023:

- 141 (88,7%) investments approved by the EIC Fund for a total close to € 630 million
- 109 companies (67,1%) with Investment Agreements signed and a total disbursed amount close to €343 million

- Over 5000 short applications submitted in 2021 and over 2500 in 2022
- Almost **2000** full applications submitted in 2021 and more than **3000** in 2022
- Over **1000** projects have been invited to interview in 2021-2022

EIC Impacts (data from 2022 Impact Report)

- Scale ups: 12 unicorns and 112 "centaurs";
- Leveraging investment: €10bn follow-on funding; total valuation ~ €40bn.
- Deep tech focus: green, digital & industry, health;
- Over 1,300 innovations identified;
- 20% of funding for women led companies under the Accelerator and over 30% women researchers in the Pathfinder
- Portfolio analysis in 7 areas (agrifood, hydrogen, energy storage, quantum, space, cell & gene therapy, neurotech)
